




EXTERNAL TARIFF OF THE EU(15) 1950-2000








EU-28 merchandise exports to extra-EU-28 by sector, 2013 shares (%)

Figure 2.3.3b: Imports of crude oil, by country of origin (Mt)






Figure 2.3.3a: Imports of natural gas, by country of origin (PJ)


